5th Grade = Comfy Cozy Read; 5th Grade Buddy Read; Drop Everything and Read Time

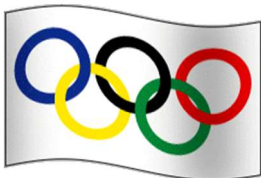
Digital Learning Specialist = Reading on "myON Reader" individually with their
